Koala Bears

Koala Bears are not bears at all. They are marsupials. A marsupial is a mammal with a pouch. They give birth to one baby at a time and the baby lives in the pouch drinking milk for about six months. That baby cannot see when it is born.

The **sharp claws** help the koala to **climb** and live in a tree. They **eat** the **leaves** from the **eucalyptus** tree in warm **Australia**.

Polar Bears

Polar bears are **mammals**. A mammal has **fur**, **live babies**, and the **babies drink milk from the mother**. Mother polar bears give birth to **two cubs** in the winter. The babies cannot see or hear so they stay in the **den**, (**snow cave**).

Polar bears live in the **Arctic**. It is very **cold** and has **snow** and **ice** there. They **hunt** for **seals** that come up from the water to get air.
